PROENERGY OPENS OFFICE IN TANZANIA

ProEnergy, a third-party provider to the energy industry, recently announced the opening of a site office in Tanzania.

ProEnergy is handling multiple projects in the East African nation. It initially constructed four trailer-mounted 2500 gas turbines capable of producing 20 megawatts each on multiple sites. Another LM 6000 capable of producing 50 megawatts will be completed this summer.

The projects, which were turn-key engineering, procurement and construction contracts, were done for a private investor selling power to Tensco. ProEnergy has a two-year operations and maintenance agreement for the project.

Tanzania, which borders the Indian Ocean and is home to Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak, is in an extreme power shortage due to its reliance on hydro-electric power and the country's current drought conditions.
